PAST MODALS (Part 2):

• CAN'T HAVE

We use can't + have + past participle (V3) to say that it is almost certain that this was impossible.

Fiona can't have gone bungee jumping with her fiancé; she has a fear of heights. Robert can't have been at the meeting; he was out of town.

• MAY / MIGHT / COULD HAVE

We use may / might / could + have + past participle to say it is likely that something would have happened in the past if circumstances had been different, or to say that by sometime in the future it is likely that something will have happened.

NOTE: We don't use can + have + past participle.

I may / might / could have accepted the job

offer if it had been in London.

I could have gone to my aunt for advice but she was abroad. (it was possible but it didn't happen.)

Jennifer may / might have seen a psychologist about her phobias. (Perhaps she did.)

a. Dim: not having much light I could see a dim light when I entered the house.

b. Injured: hurt or physically harmed The dog was badly injured after a car had hit it.

c. Wreck: badly damaged vehicle We saw a ship wreck while we were walking by the beach.

d. Kitten: a very young cat He realised that there was a hungry and shivering kitten under his car.

e. Deserted: empty, no people around The police found the stolen car in a deserted area.
