However, the term 'festivalis', which is used as an adjective form of 'Festa' in French, came into English. It was used for the days that were celebrated as religious feasts. The adjective became a noun in time, as people stopped talking about 'festival days' and shortened it to 'festivals'. The festivals play an important role in acting as stress relievers and help us balance our emotions from day to day, the exhausting routine of life, and inspiring us to remember the important things and moments in life. Festivals were started to pass the legends, knowledge and traditions to the next generation.
