KONU SIMPLE FUTURE TENSE (WILL / WON'T)

- Gelecek planlarımızı farklı zaman kalıplarıyla ifade etmek (WILL / TO BE GOING TO)
- Gelecek zamanda kullanılan zaman ifadeleri (Time expressions)

Simple Future Tense (WILL / WON'T)

When we make a sentence with Simple Future Tense, there is no plan or intention. Will / won't is used when we talk about a decision given at the moment of speaking.

Affirmative	I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	will	leave in 10 minutes.
Negative	I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	will not / won't	leave in 10 minutes.
Interrogative	Will	I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	leave in 10 minutes?

Examples:

- I will be very rich one day.
- Summer will come again.
- She won't come with us because she is busy now.
- Will you answer my question please? This is the third time I'm asking.
- Everywhere is in a mess. What will you do now?
- These bags are heavy. I'll ask for help.

With the verbs 'think, hope, believe, be sure' and adverbs 'perhaps, probably' we also use will / won't.

- I'm sure they'll help me. (Eminim bana yardım edecekler.)
- He'll probably pass his class. (Muhtemelen sınıfını geçecek.)
- Perhaps she'll talk to me. (Belki de benimle konuşacak.)
- I think I'll win. (Sanırım kazanacağım.)

Future with BE GOING TO

Affirmative:

Mary called this morning. We're going to meet at 7 this evening. They aren't going to stay at a hotel on holiday. Are you going to have Maths lesson on Friday? What are you going to do next weekend?

Tomorrow, tomorrow morning, next week, two days later, soon
