





Materials Required	Tapescript 10.3 Worksheet in Appendix A Worksheet in Appendix B
Aims	To understand common expressions about likes and dislikes To talk about the animals they like/dislike
Procedures	 The teacher asks lead in question. The teacher plays the Tapescript 10.3. S/he asks the students to tick the animals Jenny likes. The teacher replays the tapescript 10.3 and asks the students to complete the statements. In speaking activity, the teacher asks the students to draw the animals they like/dislike and say the animals they like/dislike.



Duration	30 minutes
Materials Required	Tapescript 10.4 Worksheet in Appendix A Worksheet in Appendix B Worksheet in Appendix C
Aims	To understand common expressions about abilities To ask and answer about abilities
Procedures	 The teacher plays the Tapescript 10.4. S/he asks the students to choose which animal Simon has got. The teacher replays the tapescript 10.4 and asks the students to put the statements in the correct order. In speaking activity, the teacher asks the students to look at the picture, ask and answer qestions as in the example. The teacher asks the students to focus on the Spotlight. S/he asks them to say the tongue twister. As a project, the teacher asks the students to prepare animal masks with waste materials and talk about the abilities of these animals.




