Materials Required	Tapescript 9.1 Worksheet in Appendix A Worksheet in Appendix B
Aims	To recognize the names of fruits To talk about the fruit they like and don't like
Procedures	 The teacher asks lead in questions to the students. S/he asks them to match the questions with the answers in Lead in b. The teacher plays the Tapescript 9.1 and asks them to put a tick for the fruit that the characters like and cross for the fruit they don't like. The teacher replays the tapescript and asks the students to complete the table. In Appendix B, the teacher asks the students to talk about the fruit they like and they don't like. In Speaking b, the teacher asks the students to work in pairs, ask and answer questions about the fruit.



Duration	30 minutes
Materials Required	Tapescript 9.2 Worksheet in Appendix A Worksheet in Appendix B Worksheet in Appendix C Different kinds of fruit
Aims	To identify instructions To give and respond to simple instructions
Procedures	 The teacher asks the students match the fruit with the statements in Lead in. The teacher plays the Tapescript 9.2 and asks the students to write the names of the children in the correct boxes. The teacher replays the tapescript and asks the students to complete the text. In Speaking section, the teacher asks the students to work in pairs. S/he asks them to give instructions to each other to prepare a fruit salad. The teacher asks the students to focus on the Spotlight in Appendix C. As a project, the teacher assigns the students to make at least eight fruit (four they like and four they don't like) using waste materials or dough. They are expected to present them in the classroom.






