Procedures	 The teacher asks the students to cut out the animals in Appendix D and paste them on the correct picture. The teacher replays the Tapescript 10.1 and asks the students to write True or False. In Speaking a, the teacher asks the students to match the words with the numbers in the picture and say. In Speaking b, the teacher asks the students to talk about the picture in Speaking a.

Procedures	 The teacher plays the Tapescript 10.2 and asks the students to tick the correct poster. The teacher replays the tapescript and asks the students draw a happy or sad face according to the dialogue. In Speaking a, the teacher asks the students to cut out the cards in Appendix D. S/he asks them to choose one of the cards and talk about the animals on this card. In Speaking b, the teacher asks the students to answer the questions and colour the suitable faces. Then s/he asks them to write the number of their likes and dislikes in the boxes.

Aims	To follow short and simple oral instructions about the numbers of the animals and nature To ask and answer questions about the numbers of the animals and the elements of nature
Procedures	 The teacher asks lead in questions about the pictures in Lead in. The teacher plays the Tapescript 10.3 and asks the students to colour the living beings according to the numbers of them in the listening text. The teacher wants the students to ask and answer questions about the numbers of the living beings in Listening a. In speaking section, the teacher asks the students to follow the instructions and find the correct exit. Then they are expected to describe the exit. The teacher asks the students to focus on the Spotlight in Appendix C. As a project, the teacher asks the students to make a model of nature and animals. S/he asks them to use the materials from nature.
