- We often use future time expressions with be going to: tomorrow, next weekend, next

Monday, etc.

## MAKING AND ANSWERING PHONE CALLS

There are some useful patterns while talking on the phone.

Answering the phone	<ul> <li>Good morning / Good afternoon/ Good evening , speaking.</li> <li>Hello, speaking.</li> <li>Hi's phone. Who is it?</li> <li>Thank you for calling How can I help you?</li> </ul>	
Introducing yourself	- Hello, I'm - Hi, this is calling. - Hi, this is speaking.	
Asking for someone or something	<ul> <li>Can / Could/ May I speak to?</li> <li>Is there?</li> <li>Is in?</li> <li>I'd like to speak to, please?</li> <li>Would be available?</li> </ul>	
Giving details of the call	<ul> <li>I'm calling about</li> <li>I'm calling to confirm the meeting tomorrow.</li> <li>Well, just a quick call to say</li> </ul>	
Mistakes	<ul> <li>I'm sorry, but I think you've got the wrong number.</li> <li>There is no one here with that name.</li> <li>Are you sure you've got the right number.</li> </ul>	
Repeating	<ul> <li>- I'm soryy, I can't hear you well.</li> <li>- It's a bad line. Could you speak loudly, please?</li> <li>- I didn't understand. Can/Could you repeat that, please?</li> <li>- Repeat it, please.</li> <li>- Say it again, please.</li> <li>- Can you speak slower, please?</li> <li>- Can you say it slowly, please?</li> <li>- I'm sorry. What did you say?</li> <li>- What?</li> <li>- I beg your pardon?</li> <li>- Pardon me/Excuse me.</li> </ul>	
Connecting someone	<ul> <li>Hang on a moment, please. I'll get him / her.</li> <li>One moment, please. I'll get him /her.</li> <li>Can you hold on a moment, please?</li> <li>Please hold on and I'll put you through to him / her.</li> <li>Just a sec.</li> <li>Just a moment, please. I'll see if available.</li> </ul>	
Taking a message	<ul> <li>- I'm sorry, is out / busy now.Would you like to leave a message?</li> <li>- Is there anyone else you would like to speak to?</li> <li>- I'm afraid he / she's just popped out. Do you want to leave a message?</li> <li>- I'll ask to call you back, anything else?</li> </ul>	
Finishing conversation	- Bye. - Talk soon. - Speak to you soon again.
