big	bigger than
big hot	hotter than

b. two-syllable adjectives ending in -y:

Adjective	Comparative
happy	happier than
easy	easier than
friendly	friendlier than

c. adjectives with two or more syllables:

Adjective	Comparative
beautiful	more beautiful than
expensive	more expensive than
famous	more famous than

d. irregular adjectives

Adjective	Comparative
good	better than
bad	worse than
far	further / farther than
