

## KONU TELEVISION AND SOCIAL MEDIA - PART A

### FUTURE SIMPLE (WILL)

#### We use the future simple:

- for predictions based on what we think or believe.**  
(usually with the verbs: hope, think, believe, expect, imagine, etc.;  
with the expressions: I'm sure, I'm afraid, etc.; with the adverbs: probably, perhaps, etc.).  
I think there will be lots of animated film stars in the future.  
Dave will probably buy a new tablet.  
I'm sure Sue will watch the Academy Awards ceremony live.
- for on the spot decisions.**  
I'm tired. I'll go home and rest.
- for promises.**  
I promise I'll keep it secret.
- for threats.**  
Stop playing football at home or I'll punish you.
- for actions and events that will definitely happen in the future, and that we cannot control.**  
Heather will be sixteen years old next month.

#### Time words / phrases used with the future simple:

Tomorrow, the day after tomorrow, next week / month / year, tonight, soon, in a week / month / year, in the future, etc.

**Note:** We never use the future simple in time clauses, after the words: when, while, before, after, etc.

#### AFFIRMATIVE

Subject	will	Verb	
I / He / She / It We / You / They	will ('ll)	meet	Jane tomorrow.

#### NEGATIVE

Subject	will not (won't)	Verb	
I / He / She / It We / You / They	will not (won't)	meet	Jane tomorrow.

#### INTERROGATIVE

Will	Subject	Verb		Short Answers
Will	I / you / he / she / it / we / you / they	meet	Jane tomorrow?	Yes, I / you / he / she / it / we / you / they will. No, I / you / he / she / it / we / you / they won't.

### Interrupting a conversation

Sorry to interrupt!  
Excuse me for interrupting, but...  
Can I stop you there for a moment?

#### Interrupting an interruption

Would you let me finish first?  
I haven't finished it yet.

#### Allowing an interruption

Ok, what do you want to add/ say?  
No problem. You can go ahead.

#### Continuing after an interruption

Where was I?  
As I was explaining/ saying.
